### About Niagara Falls, Canada


The City of Niagara Falls Canada is located along the Niagara River in the Province of Ontario. Approximately 80,000 people live in the City of Niagara Falls. Over 16 million tourists visit Niagara Falls every year.

Niagara Falls is 618 feet (189 meters) above sea level. The Canadian Falls, also known as the Horseshoe Falls, are 2,200 feet (670 meters) wide and 173 feet high (53 meters). The speed of the Niagara River at the crest of the falls is 20 miles per hour (32 km/h). More than 600,000 gallons of water per second flow over the Horseshoe Falls making it the third greatest natural water falls in the world. The water depth at the base of the Horseshoe Falls is 184 feet (56m).

The Niagara River, together with the Nile, are the only two rivers in the world that flow north. The Niagara River is 35 miles long (59 km) and flows north from its origin at Lake Erie to its destination in Lake Ontario. The Niagara River is as wide as 8500 feet (2580 meters) at Buffalo/Fort Erie to as narrow as narrow as 1500 feet (460 meters) at Squaw Island located below the Peace Bridge. Water flowing past the Peace Bridge can rush along at over 8 miles per hour. The Niagara River varies in depth from 150 feet (46 meters) at the base of the Horseshoe Falls to 215 feet (65 meters) at the Whirlpool Bridge and 100 feet (30 meters) at the Queenston - Lewiston bridge.




